





PAW-SOME PET FACTS

Big Buck loves hanging out with pets! He likes that each of them has its own personalty and keeps him and his barnyard buddies happy and entertained.

His favorites are dogs and cats and he considers them his best friends. But the farm also gives Big Buck a chance to get to know (and love) other animals too. Did your favorite pet make the paw-some pet facts list below?





Just like human fingerprints, each cat's nose has a unique pattern. But most likely you would identify a cat by its markings or personality, not its nose! Cats sleep for around 70% of their lives, which can be up to 16 hours a day. Their whiskers are highly sensitive and can detect changes in air currents, helping them navigate in the dark.



There are thousands of different species of pet fish, each with its unique colors, shapes, and behaviors. The most popular pet fish is the goldfish. Goldfish have teeth at the back of their throats that they use to grind food. The world's longest goldfish was found in the Netherlands in 2003. It measured 18 1/2 inches long! That's one big pet fish!



Dogs have an impressive memory. They can remember and recognize their human family members and other animals even after being separated for a long time. They can sense human emotions and often provide comfort and support. Understanding and appreciating the uniqueness of each dog is part of the joy of having them as companions.



Reptiles have been around for more than 300 million years! Many reptiles have the ability to regenerate body parts. For example, some lizards can regrow their tails if they lose them due to predation or other reasons. Remember that caring for a pet reptile requires knowledge of its specific requirements, including proper heating, lighting, and diet.



Rodents make up the largest order of mammals, with over 2,000 species. Common pet rodents include mice, rats, hamsters, gerbils, guinea pigs, and chinchillas. All rodents have a pair of continuously growing teeth that need to be worn down regularly. Gnawing on items like wood, toys, or specialized chews helps keep their teeth at an appropriate length.



Many pet birds, such as parrots, can mimic human speech. African Grey Parrots, in particular, are known for their exceptional ability to imitate and understand words. Birds are social animals and thrive on companionship. It's essential for their well-being to spend time with their owners or other birds.

SMART MONEY HABITS

Age 10-12: At this age, your child should start figuring out how to make their own shopping decisions. Now would be a good time to teach them about buying generic instead of name brands, and looking for deals. Review your receipt with them after your shopping trip and show them how much money you saved by buying things on sale or buying a less-expensive brand.

No matter what age your child is, it's never too early to open a savings account. It's one of the best learning tools to give your child hands-on experience when it comes to saving and budgeting.




